

NSW Climbing Team Coach: 2020 - 2022

Volunteer position reporting to the SCNSW/ACT Board

Purpose:

- To represent NSW competitors as an official at National competitions.
- To build a more cohesive NSW Climbing Team for National events.
- To give NSW climbers representing or aspiring to represent Australia regular, hands-on coaching sessions especially with regards to competition climbing.
- To provide a forum for coaches across the state to share knowledge and experience.

Coach responsibilities:

- Attend State and National championships to:
 - Act on behalf of team members in the event of an appeal
 - Assist team members with their competition preparation
- Be a member of the NSW Team Selection Committee for National competitions.
- Keep up to date with ASADA level two online training
- Coordinate regular coaching and/or team building activities across a variety of venues.
 - A fee of up to \$20 per participant per activities, may be collected by the coach to cover costs.
- Consult with participants on training programs they can use independently between training sessions and provide participants with the skills to monitor their own training.

Support from SCNSW/ACT:

The coach will be featured on the SCNSW/ACT website.

A Team Manager will assist the State Coach to:

- Organise and advertise team activities
- Coordinate distribution of uniforms, certificates and other NSW State Team insignia.
- Provide financial assistance to travel to interstate competitions if funding is available
- Maintain team lists and contact details and manage communications to the team

The preferred candidate will have:

- Minimum climbing experience at state competition level
- Strong understanding of SCA National Competition Policy and Rules
- Basic route setting or strong route reading ability
- Coaching experience
- A working with children check
- Good organisation skills
- Membership of SCNSW/ACT
- Current standard First Aid Certificate (preferred)
